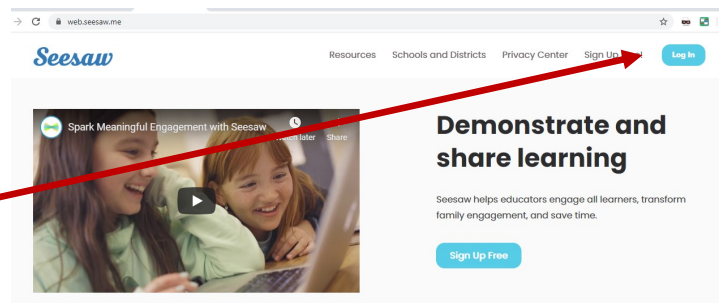


Seesaw Online Learning Guide

The following is a user guide to Seesaw if the need should arise for your child to self-isolate for any period of time.

Kindergarten 1, 2 and Reception will use Seesaw as our online learning platform. Years 1 and 2 will be using it alongside Zoom. All children that are using Seesaw, even if they have used it previously, will need to follow this guide in order to get into their new digital classrooms. Any previous log in details will not work as those details have been archived to the previous academic year.

1. Go to web.seesaw.me and click 'Log In

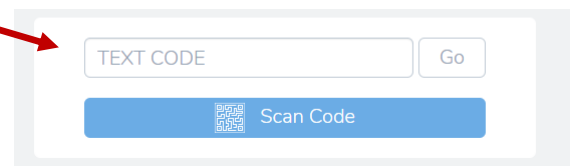


2. On the next page, click 'I'm a Student'



3. In the lower half of the next page it gives you the opportunity to insert a 'TEXT CODE' or scan the QR Code. You will receive a separate email with the code (16 digits), and a hard copy of the letter that has the QR Code. Using either the code or QR Code will result in the same outcome.

N.B. This code has a built in password, which gives you automatic access to your child's account. Please do not share on social media or on any public accessible place on the internet.



4. There is an Android and IOS App that you can also link your child's account to. This works on most platforms including iPads and Amazon Fire.

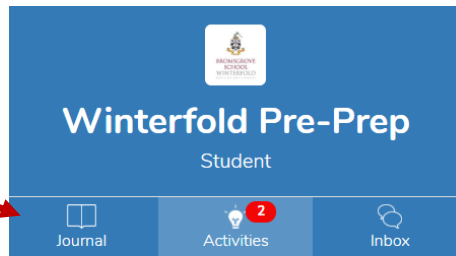
The App is excellent for sharing completed work back with the teacher for them to mark and interact with.



My Online Experience

Once your child is logged on, the right hand side of the screen is where all of the actions happen from.

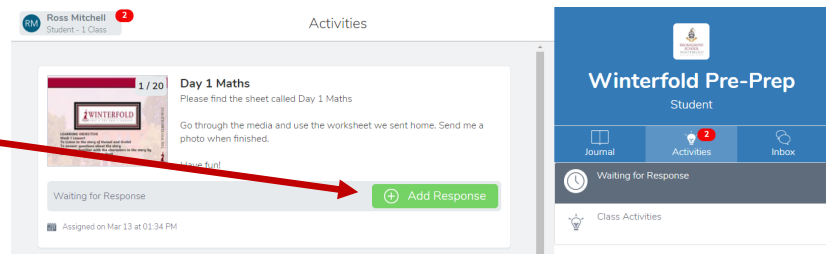
'Journal' is the area in which all of your child's submitted work can be seen.



'inbox' is where all of the interactive aspects of the app take place. Your child will be notified when they have an alert.

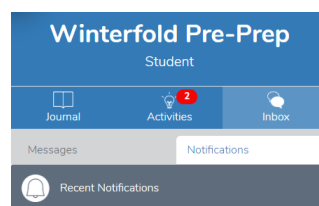
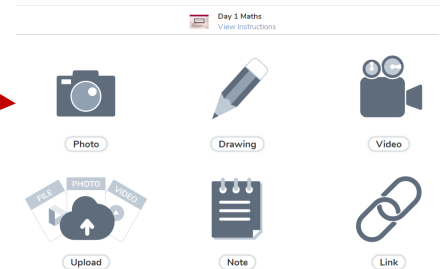
When your child's teacher submits a new task, they will be seen in the form of a notification in the 'Activities' tab.

Inside of each 'Activity' set by the teacher there are 3 components; instructions, an example or PPT images and 'Add Response'

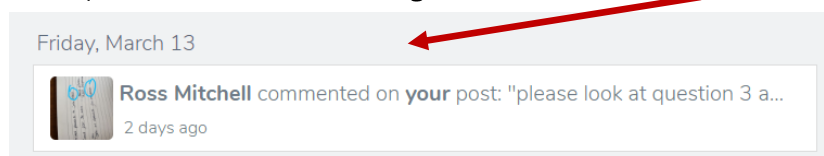


When adding a response there are 6 options. The one that will be most frequently used will be 'Photo'.

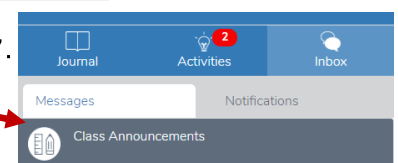
This will require the children to take an image of their completed work, click the green tick which will submit it to their teacher.



Once they have submitted their work, they will receive a 'Notification' once the teacher has seen and commented on it in their 'Inbox'. There are two parts to the 'Inbox'; 'Messages' and 'Notifications'



Inside the 'Inbox', the section that says 'Messages' will have 'Class Announcements'. These are more informational statements that cannot be responded to.



We have chosen this software as it has an excellent balance between interactive teacher support, independent learning and a balanced screen time. It will require some input from parents, but we feel that it is incredibly user friendly for the younger members of our community.
